Since the image we project says something about us as individuals as well as a Catholic educational facility, it is our goal to maintain and promote the spirit of proper modesty while projecting the highest degree of professionalism in our dress and personal grooming, as well as our conduct. Faculty members' and volunteers' clothing should be neat, clean, and presentable, while abiding within the following guidelines:

Men

- •Dress shirt with tie
- Dress slacks
- •Dress shoes (no tennis shoes)
- •Hair should be conservatively cut and neatly trimmed
- No earrings

Women

- •No tight clothing
- •Skirts or dresses (no slits and cover knees while standing and sitting)
- •Blouse may not be sheer, and sleeves must reach halfway to elbow
- •Necklines must be no lower than 2-3 finger spaces beneath the pit of the throat
- •Tops must cover midriff when bending over or arms raised
