Pre-Lenten Season

The three Sundays preceding Ash Wednesday are called Septuagesima, Sexagesima and Quinquagesima, which mean, respectively, the seventieth, sixtieth, and fiftieth day, that is, before Easter.

These three weeks form a transition from the joy of Christmastide to the austerity of the penitential season of Lent. This is the season when the Church most earnestly invites her children to prepare properly for the feast of Christ's glorious Resurrection. She urges us to rise from and expiate our sins, to practice prayer and charity with greater zeal, and to become indeed new men through God's grace

- ◆ **Catechism Classes:** Parents are reminded of their serious obligation to provide for the religious instruction of their children. Catechism classes for school-aged children are held every Sunday, September through May.
- ◆ **Stipends:** If you would like to have a Mass offered for your intentions, please use one of the envelopes provided in the vestibule. **Mass requests for a specific date should be submitted at least 1 month in advance.** The normal stipend offering of those of ordinary financial means is: Mass intention—\$25; baptisms—\$25; weddings—\$100. Stipends are given not in payment for spiritual benefits, but as a means of support for the priest.
